Mineral Sector - Foreign trade performance 2017

The external trade of the mineral sector that encompasses mining (extractive industry, except oil and gas) and mineral transformation (metallic, non-metallic and inorganic chemical compounds) closed 2017 with a positive balance of US\$ 19.8 billion equivalent to US\$ 42.8 billion of exports and US\$ 23.0 billion of imports. The participation of the mineral sector in the brazilian exports was 20% (iron ore alone 8.8% of the total brazilian exports).

Mining (extractive, except oil and gas)

Exports of the mining sector only in 2017 totaled US\$ 24.0 billion equivalent to 52% of the total exports of the mineral sector and 11% of the Brazilian exports. The shipments of iron ore (the main export item of the sector), increased by 2.6%, from 374 million tons in 2016 to 383 million tons in 2017.
